<u>Child Care Supply</u>: Regulated slots (each slot being space for one child) were used to identify the capacity and market share for each type of program or zip code in the county. The number of children receiving Wisconsin Shares child care subsidies is based on reports from the state's child care billing system for April 2016. On the back of this page is data on family child care rates, benefits and education from the 4-C 2016 survey of child care providers in Columbia County. More information is available on the <u>4-C website</u>. There are two child care centers that are nationally accredited as meeting high quality standards. 188 children were on Wisconsin Shares. 34 were in care outside the county.
