

## GREEN COUNTY EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CHILD CARE REPORT 2017

**Child Care Supply**: Regulated slots (each slot being space for one child) were used to identify the capacity and market share for each type of program or zip code in the county. The number of children receiving Wisconsin Shares child care subsidies is based on reports from the state's child care billing system for April 2016. The state has implemented a new voluntary rating program for child care programs called YoungStar – to view the definitions of each star level go to www.youngstar.wi.gov. The number of children receiving Wisconsin Shares subsidies declined 12%. The rates get higher the closer the program is to Dane County.
