



# DANE COUNTY EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION DEMOGRAPHIC REPORT 2017

The State Of Wisconsin has yet to get us the Wisconsin child care subsidy data from April 2017 needed to complete this report. Given the rest of the data is in, 4-C decided to publish an interim report so the other enrollment data will be available to the field. Once the subsidy data is available this report will be expanded and finished.

Enrollment data is from 2017. Enrollment data below does not include numbers from unregulated public/private school preschool or after school programs- those are covered later in the report. Family child care and part day Preschool enrollment continued to decline. Enrollment in regulated care for all children under age 5 saw a decline. School age care saw a major increase in all categories of programs.

The number of children in high quality five star programs as well as overall capacity increased. Five star programs also have far fewer open slots than any other category. A chart covering unlicensed public and private school programs for children under age six is on page 3 of this report. 12% of the preschool enrollment in state licensed child care is currently funded at least partially by the public schools a decline from last year. Public Preschool enrollment also had no significant increase from 2016.

**Overall there is an estimated 2271 empty slots (over 11% of total capacity) in regulated family child care, full day group centers and school age programs in Dane County.** One problem in filling slots seems to be finding teaching staff more than lack of demand for programs. A short survey in 2016 showed about half the slots in Dane county empty due to lack of staff. Overall child care enrollment indicates that Dane County is out of the recession. Cost may be a major deterrent to using regulated care based on cost of living studies 4-C did in 2016. That study showed over 10% of the families with children under the age of 5 probably priced out of the child care market. Surveys also suggest that educated millennial parents want to spend more time with their children and thus use child care less.

In this report there may be some minor variations in total enrollments between some of the different geographic charts involving the City of Madison. This is usually due to the fact that census tracts, school enrollment areas, and neighborhood planning areas vary and often include areas outside the city. In some cases the data can be limited to just the city of Madison and in others the data cannot. Throughout this report there are references to Wisconsin's YoungStar quality rating and improvement system for child care programs, including an analysis of the number of programs at each of the various quality star ratings in each zip code in Dane County. An explanation of YoungStar is on page 15.

City Accredited and City Accreditations refer to programs accredited by the City of Madison Child Care Unit in the city's Community development Division.

## PUBLIC SCHOOL PROGRAMS IN DANE COUNTY FOR CHILDREN UNDER AGE SIX 2015-2016

Public Schools in Dane County increasingly are providing additional programs for children under age 6.

These include: pre-kindergarten programming for children at risk (listed on the chart as preK); regular kindergarten for children age 5 (5K), usually offered in a full day format; and 4 year old kindergarten (4K). There are also private schools offering both 4K and kindergarten which are exempt from state licensing.

Publicly funded 4 year old kindergarten (4K), usually offered as a part day program, is offered in all Dane County school districts. The models for it vary from district to district. Depending on the district, it can be either in the local public schools or by subcontract in various state licensed child care centers, preschools or head start programs. The arrangements for the latter vary from district to district. Quite often the district provides the state certified teachers but in some situations the state certified teacher is on the staff of the center.

The data in the below chart is from the 2015-2016 public and private school annual enrollment report on the Wisconsin Department of Instruction Website. It is presented by school district not municipality. 4k data is presented in total for each district but also split between in public school and in licensed programs categories. 4k enrollment data for state licensed programs is included as part of the preschool numbers in the other charts within this report. The in school 4k data, the Kindergarten and pre-K numbers represent children in programs but which are not included in the other charts in this paper which are limited to state regulated programs outside the public schools. If you add in the public and private school preschool numbers to the total in regulated care there are 16,030 children under age 5 in some type of preschool program in Dane County (and that does not include 5,531 five year olds in public school kindergartens). These figures need to be considered when planning additional preschool care or early childhood programs. See chart on page 7 for zip code analysis.

### WHAT DOES EACH STAR RATING MEAN?

Each star rating is based on these four categories of quality:

**Provider Education and Training** - Children benefit when their teachers and caregivers have a solid foundation in early care and education principles and practices. YoungStar acknowledges the academic achievement of teachers/caregivers and administrators.

**Learning Environment and Curriculum** - When teachers and caregivers create meaningful experiences for children, they are more likely to have long-term school and life success.

**Business and Professional Practices** - How programs do business matters. Well-respected, fairly-compensated professionals, who are actively maintaining professional standards and business practices and engaging families, are better able to respond to meet the needs of children and their families.

**Health and Wellness** - Children grow up in the context of their families, communities, and culture. These standards look at the outcomes of the whole child from nutrition and physical activity to meeting special needs and being responsive to how kids form relationships.

### HOW DO PROVIDERS EARN THEIR STAR RATING?

Star ratings can be earned in any of the following ways:

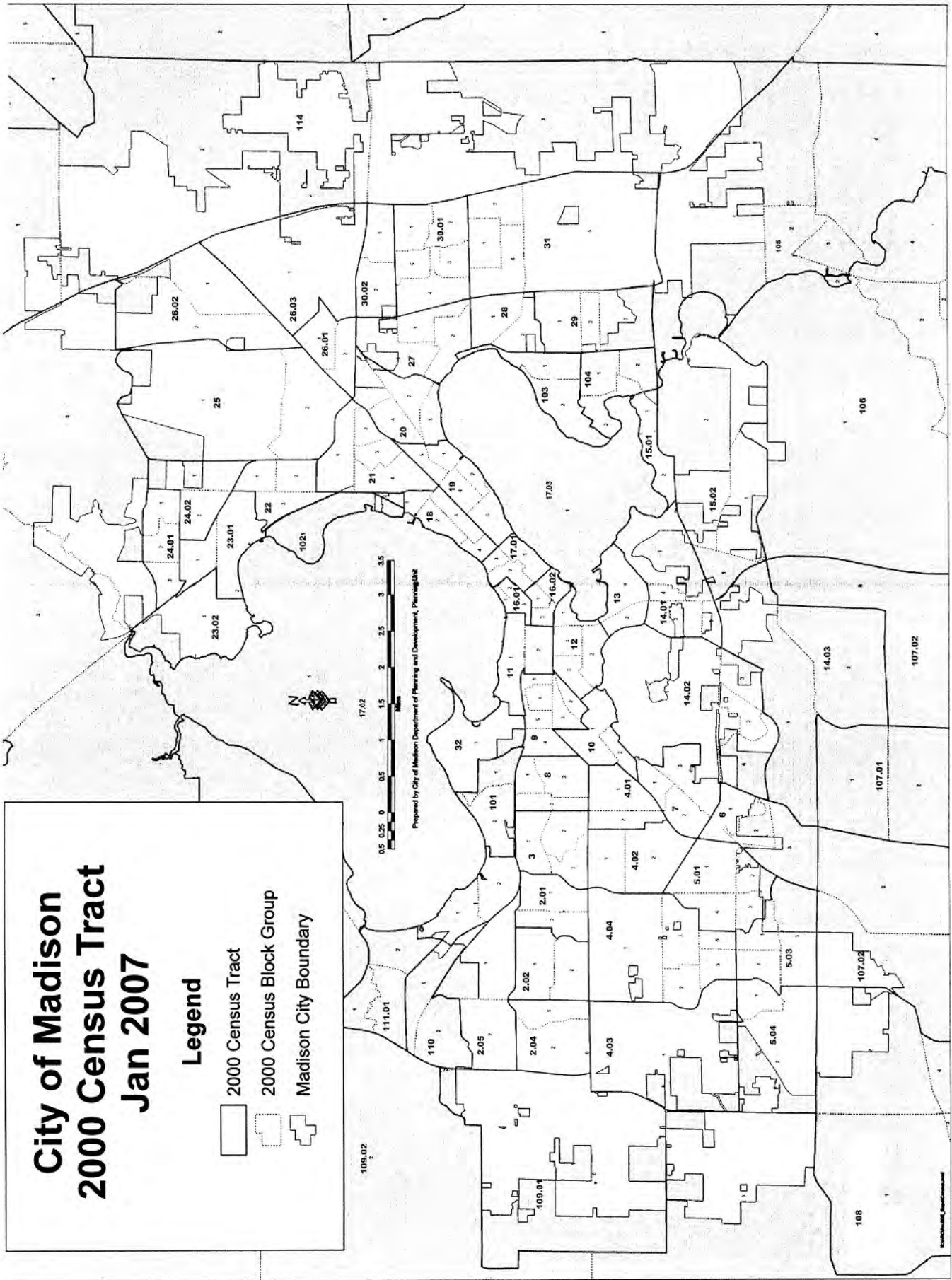
